



Installation procedure for D-Link modem on Windows Vista

Please complete the following procedure for the Installation of all D-Link Modems (version C1 only) on Windows Vista:

*Note – for best results, the modem must **not** be plugged to the computer during installation*

- Step 1** Insert disk
- Step 2** Click on 'Install Drivers'
- Step 3** Select 'Windows 98se/ME/2000/XP'
- Step 4** Select 'Allow'
- Step 5** Select 'Wan' driver and then click on 'Next'
- Step 6** Leave settings as they are (VPI=0, VCI=38, encapsulation=Multimode) and select 'Next'
- Step 7** Software will begin to install
- Step 8** Security question will appear. Click on 'Install this driver anyway'
- Step 9** Software will ask that the modem be plugged into a USB port
- Step 10** Once done, the program will run to the end and the modem is now installed

The next part of the procedure is to create a connection:

- Step 1** Click on 'Start'
- Step 2** Go to 'Control Panel' (select classic View)
- Step 3** Double Click on 'Network and Sharing Centre'
- Step 4** Click On 'Set up a Connection'
- Step 5** Select 'Set up a Dial-up Connection'



Enter the settings below (in lower case):

Number to dial - 0,38

Username - for example, user@gibconnect.com (your username must be followed by the suffix @gibconnect.com)

Password - *****

Click on 'Connect' to create the connection and to connect

Unlike Windows XP and other operating systems, Windows Vista does not automatically create an ADSL dial up shortcut on your desktop. To create one manually please complete the steps below:

- Step 1** From the 'Start Menu' select 'Control Panel'
- Step 2** Select 'Network and Internet category' and then select 'Network and Sharing Center'
- Step 3** Select 'Manage Network Connections' from the pane on the window's left side. (Clicking that option reveals all your network connections, including your dial-up Internet connection)
- Step 4** Right-click your dial-up Internet icon and choose 'Create Shortcut' from the pop-up menu
- Step 5** Click 'OK' to allow the shortcut to be automatically placed on the Desktop

Alternatively if you do not wish to create a shortcut you must then:

Click on 'Start'

Go to 'Connect to'. One of the options appearing should be the Dial-up connection you created. Click on it

Ensure that your username and password are entered correctly and click 'Connect'. You will be connected
