

Highlights of 2011

Customers at all levels continued to benefit from Gibtelecom's price reductions, service upgrades and community events throughout 2011

January 2011

Powered by Gibtelecom, the Gibraltar Chess Festival saw its ninth installment in 2011, cementing itself as one of the leading open tournaments in the world.

February 2011

Gibtelecom launched its new Wi-Fi portal, allowing users to purchase internet access at various Wi-Fi hotspots across different locations around Gibraltar.

Europe India Gateway (EIG) submarine cable was partially activated allowing connectivity to 11 out of the 13 landing sites (including Gibraltar) on the cable's UK to Libya portion.

March 2011

Gibtelecom introduced measures to notify its customers on local data usage.

May 2011

Fixed line to mobile call rate reductions, offering savings of up to 25%.

July 2011

Local mobile internet charges reduced by as much as 33%. July also saw reductions in EU roaming charges with incoming call rates reduced from 12p to 9p and reload data roaming from £1.15 to 75p per MB.

August 2011

Together with the Ministry of Culture, Gibtelecom sponsored the ever popular Summer Nights held at Casemates Square.

November 2011

Calling a fixed line from reload was reduced by 3p per minute. Contract SMS reduced across the board and savings of up to 50% introduced on reload SMS Bundles.
