

Gibraltar International Chess Festival

Gibtelecom once again a leading supporter of the Tradewise Gibraltar International Chess Festival, now in its 14th year

The 2016 Tradewise Gibraltar Chess Festival, "powered by Gibtelecom" was once more a hugely successful tournament, with over 50 countries being represented. This year's festival, held at the Caleta Hotel, ran from Monday 25 January to Thursday 4 February. The tournament saw the participation of over 300 players, including 77 Grandmasters. Of the 17 top women players in the world, 12 of them participated in the Gibraltar tournament.

Gibtelecom has been involved since the very first tournament held over a decade ago and was the lead sponsor till 2009. Gibtelecom continues to take an active role in the festival providing sponsorship monies and the technology that supports the website www.gibraltarchesscongress.com along with the broadcasting of the commentary around the world.

Gibtelecom also supports and transmits "The Day's Play", a daily afternoon show highlighting the latest stories, interviews and other special moments from the festival which was introduced last year. This short programme was also shown on GBC each evening of the tournament. A documentary capturing the essence of chess and the Gibraltar Festival called "All the Right Moves" was also sponsored by Gibtelecom and was shown at this year's tournament, and can now be purchased on VIMEO.

The 2016 Masters competition was for the second year running won by the current USA No 1 and World No 7 Grandmaster, Hikaru Nakamura. Winning the top prize of £20,000, this is the third time Mr Nakamura has taken the top Gibraltar slot, his first win being in 2008. French Grandmaster Maxime Vachier-Lagrave won the second top prize, receiving £16,000, with the top Women's prize of £15,000 going to Grandmaster Anna Muzychuk from Ukraine. Ms Muzychuk also came seventeenth in the Masters tournament.
